Trail marked Paths
The "Explore Rannoch Path network - Around Kinloch Rannoch" leaflet is available for sale in Kinloch Rannoch and other outlets.
Carrie & South Rannoch Forest has three scenic trail marked routes.

Core Paths on Estate tracks
Many of the tracks found on the OS maps in Rannoch are "Drove Roads"
These long distant routes were used to bring cattle from the Highlands to markets in central Scotland. Walk as far as you want, when you turn to come home you will see yet more fabulous views. Use OS maps to find the tracks.

Points of Interest

1. Clan Trail around Loch Rannoch. Heroic deeds and dark terror on plaques located at various sites. Leaflets available in shops Kinloch Rannoch.
2. Play park, picnic area and swings - Weller Polley Park Kinloch Rannoch
3. Loch Rannoch, the only loch in Europe with 3 distinct morphs of Arctic Charr "Ice Age" fish. Interpretation board at war memorial, and viewpoint, Kinloch Rannoch.
4. Allt Mor Waterfall and hydro scheme.
5. Kinloch Rannoch walks and picnic site. (leaflet available in Kinloch Rannoch)
6. Parking at Kiltichonan car park - sand and picnic places.
7. Sandy beaches.
8. Rannoch Station. Interpretation centre - Rannoch Moor and building the railway. Take a train trip on the West Highland Line, one of the most beautiful in Scotland, with Harry Potter connections.
9. Crannog - Bronze-age artificial island with folly built in the 19th century. A reconstruction of a small island prison.
10. Jess Mary's Bay. Viewpoint and home of historic figure.
11. Camghouran burn - short walk to beautiful waterfalls.
12. The Black Wood of Rannoch - An excellent example of Ancient Caledonian Forest.
13. 4 cairns starting at Garry Bridge - story of the Road to the Isles.
14. Rannoch, an important supplier of green energy since 1930's, has large sites and dams with interconnection boards. Now micro schemes such as Allt Mor let you see inside a turbine shed.

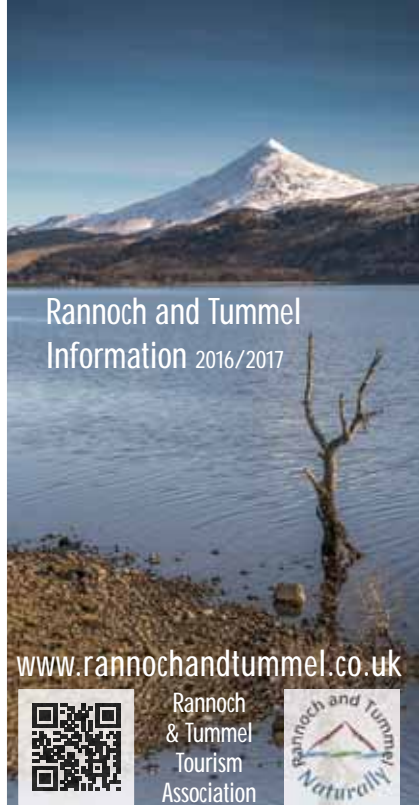

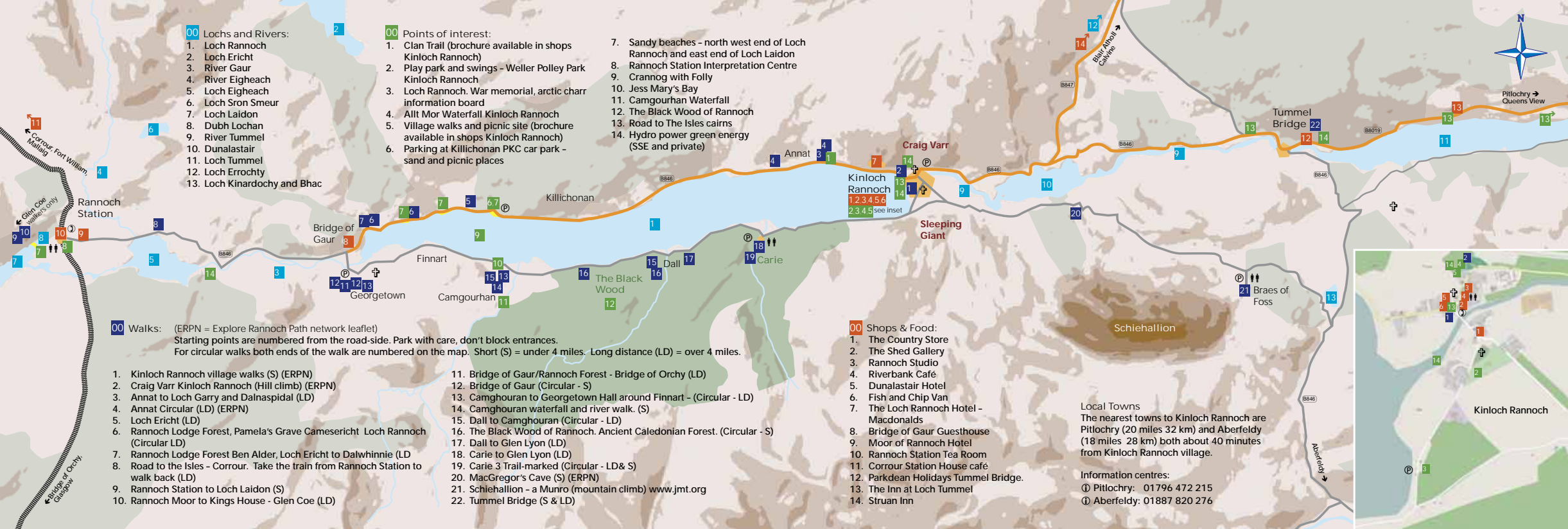
