**Trail marked Paths**

**Core Paths on Estate tracks**  
Many of the tracks found on the OS maps in Rannoch are "Driver Roads". These long, straight routes were used to bring cattle from the Highlands to markets in central Scotland. Walk as far as you want, when you turn to come home you will see very many fabulous views. Use OS maps to find the tracks.

Respect the interests of other people and care for the environment. Keep dogs under control near livestock and deer.  
Local employment depends on deer remaining undisturbed at certain times of year. Your co-operation at these times is important to us.

**Ticks and Lyme disease** Check for small spider-like creatures on yourself and dogs. Remove carefully with tweezers as close to the skin as possible, do not twist.

## Points of Interest

**1** Cairn Trail around Loch Rannoch. Historic deeds and dark tales on plaques located at various sites. Leaflets available in shops Kirkcubbin Rannoch.

**2** Play park, picnic area and swings - Walker Play Park Kirkcubbin Rannoch

**3** Loch Rannoch, the only loch in Europe with 1 distinct morph of Arctic Char "Ice Age" fish. Interpretation board at sea memorial, and viewpoint, Kirkcubbin Rannoch.

**4** All Moor Waterfall and hydro scheme.

**5** Kirkcubbin Rannoch walks and picnic site. (leaflet available in Kirkcubbin Rannoch)

**6** Parking at Kirkcubbin car park - sand and picnic places.

**7** Sandy beaches.

**8** Rannoch Station, Interpretation centre - Rannoch Moor and building the railway. Take a walk up on the West Highland Line, one of the most beautiful in Scotland, with Harry Potter connections.

**9** Crannog - Bronze-age artificial island with fairy hulk in the 19th century. A reconstruction of a small island priory.

**10** Joe May's Bay Viewpoint and home of historic figure.

**11** Congarhan burn - short walk to beautiful waterfall.

**12** The Black Wood of Rannoch - An excellent example of Ancient Caledonian Forest.

**13** 4 corners starting at Gary Bridge - story of the Road to the Isles.

**14** Rannoch, an important supplier of game energy since 1899's, has large sites and dams with interpretation boards. New music schemes such as All Moor let you see inside a turbine shed.

**15** Rannoch Equestrian.
